Conditions associated with the awarding of Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma and Master in Mental Health (General Practice) Scholarships

1. Preamble

- 1.1 The NSW Institute of Psychiatry supports a number of Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma and Master in Mental Health (General Practice) Scholarships.
- 1.2 The number and nature of these are determined from time to time by the NSW Health Department.
- 1.3 Only in the most exceptional circumstances will a Scholarship be wholly granted outside the State of NSW.

2. Eligibility and obligations

- 2.1 The student will be a General Practitioner or General Practice Registrar.
- 2.2 The student will be working as a General Practitioner or General Practice Registrar for a minimum of three clinical practice sessions per week.
- 2.3 The student will reside in NSW.
- 2.4 The student will work in NSW.
- 2.5 The student will complete the Scholarship Application Form.
- 2.6 The student should intend to complete the studies for which they have been given a scholarship.
- 2.7 The student will actively participate in the evaluations of the course.
- 2.8 The student will actively participate in the course studies, assessments, tutorials and workshops.

3. Selection

- 3.1 Scholarships will be granted by the Institute on the basis of advice from the Course Advisory Committee.
- 3.2 The selection process will include, but not be restricted to:
 - Review of Scholarship Application.
 - Location of practice (eg. Rural, regional, metropolitan)

4. Tenure

- 4.1 Scholarships are granted for 24 credit points.
- 4.2 The Institute reserves the right to terminate the Scholarship should the student's work be of an unsatisfactory standard as assessed by the Institute.

5. Scholarship details

- 5.1 The scholarship is limited to the fees payable for the units.
- 5.2 The student will be financially and administratively responsible for their travelling and accommodation costs for tutorials and workshops.

6. Publications

- 6.1 The Institute would appreciate receiving a copy of any publications written by Scholarship recipients on mental health related matters during or post attendance of the course.
